





**Registration Instructions:**

- 1 Course selection will be done in person at the Department as per above schedule on first come first serve basis. You should plan to come early & collect a token number from M.Engg. office in the Department. Students will be entertained based on their token number.
- 2 For evening Programme, the maximum no. of courses you can register for a semester is 2. You must register one compulsory and one elective course if you are selecting 2 courses, or one compulsory course if you are selecting only one course, unless your requirement of compulsory courses is already completed.
- 3 For morning & weekend programme, you may register for upto 4 courses However, you are recommended not to take more than 3 courses or else your GPA may suffer. Make Combinations of compulsory & elective courses.
- 4 After selection of courses, you are required to complete the online registration and pay the required fees on the voucher generated after online registration.
- 5 Your registration for Fall semester 2023 will be deemed cancelled if the above procedure is not strictly adhered to.
